Original: Shaula Glarus (1904-1988), born in Galilee, Palestine. She studied at the Hebrew Gymnasium in Tel Aviv, after which she continued to the Hebrew School of Art in Jerusalem. In 1924, she traveled to Paris, where she studied at the painting academy of the painter André Borel, and at the Académie de la Grande Chaumière.

During her sojourn in Paris, she was exposed to new European styles of painting. In 1948, after repatriation to Israel in the Venice Biennale and in 1950 she returned

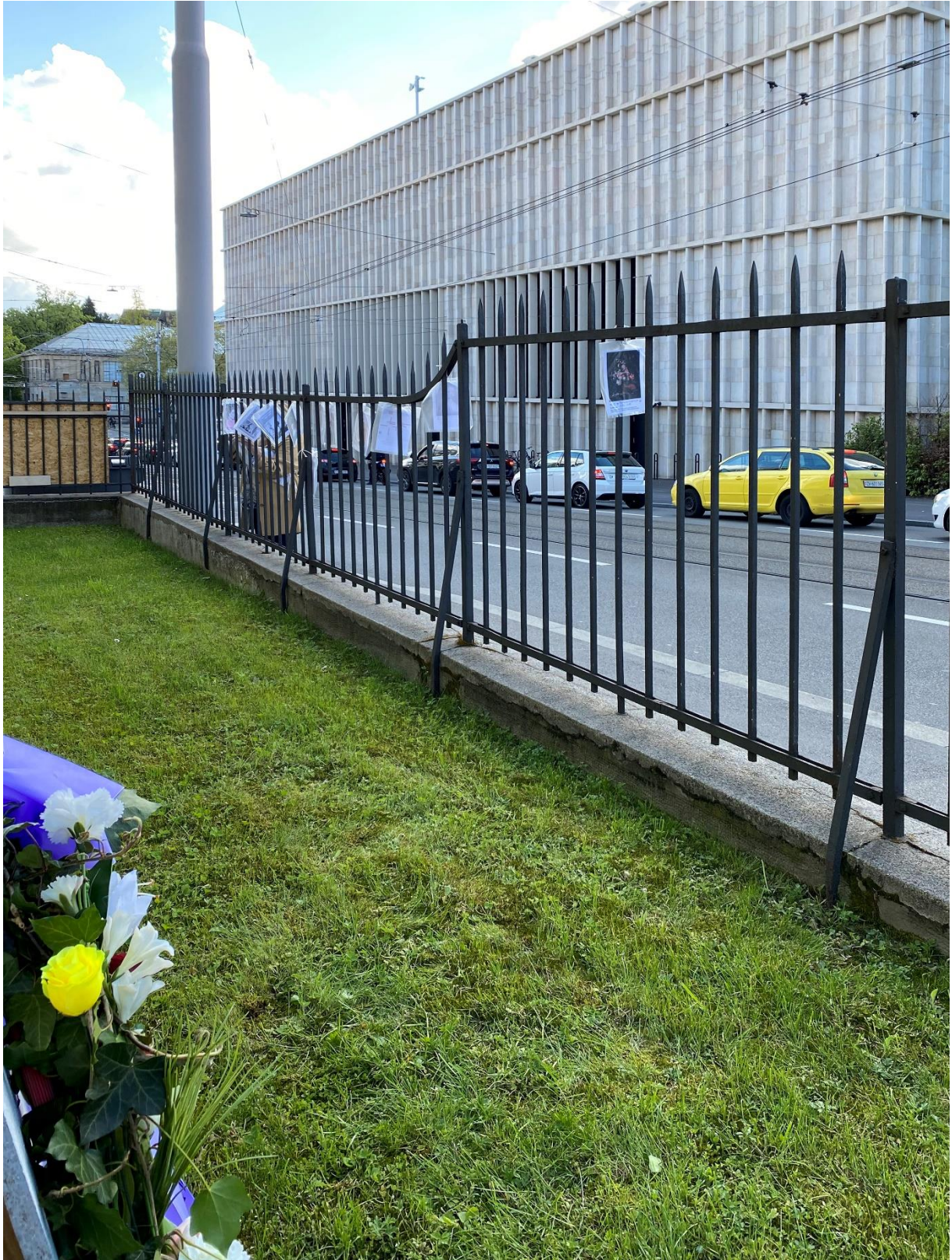
